

Sandra Duffy, JD Keynote Speaker 7pm, Friday Oct 12

Ms Duffy is Board President of Consumers for Dental Choice, and has been involved in legal challenges to FDA for failure to protect the public from mercury fillings. She has authored bills for the Oregon and Washington legislatures seeking a phase-out of mercury in dental



fillings, defended the right of dentists to advertise mercury-free practices, and helped enlist the ACLU to challenge state dental boards for prohibiting dentists from recommending the removal of amalgams as a potential toxic risk.

Clinton Miller Keynote Speaker Awards Banquet, Saturday Oct 13

Clinton Miller was the author and moving force behind "The Proxmire Vitamin Bill" of 1976, which stopped the FDA from enacting regulations which would require



most high potency vitamin and mineral supplements to be sold as prescription drugs. He is the father of the "Human Guinea Pig Amendment", which required for the first time in history that people used in medical experiments have to give their informed consent. He has led State and Federal battles against compulsory water fluoridation, immunization and pasteurization for five decades. Clinton served the National Health Federation from 1962 to 1989, as lobbyist, Vice President, and Executive Director.
